### Meet Pilot Butte Middle School – Authorized in 2014 About us...

Y3 Students at our school site

240 8th grade students - 61% SES, Sped - 38, EL-17 - 4 Life Skills

Our district has 5 middle schools (87 MS students are considered homeless).

Master Schedule

8 classes (50 minute periods) Design/PE-Health (Day1/Day2 in Grade 8)

Prior experience with 8GCP

One year of trying out the systems and service piece of the 8GCP in 2015-16

New changes for our second year

Teacher who began the 8GCP and led it the previous year, took a new job in October 1, 2016 and we started 8GCP started November 1, 2016










#### Design Cycle vs. Community Project Cycle










# School's Leadership Team Background Work













## School-Wide Systems (Goal 1-8 supervisor/Students)

- Assembly Schedule Days (4 x during the 8GCP) to meet with supervisors (20 staff members as supervisors)
- 6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup> Grader students (approximately 500) were given exposure to LP traits, community action on campus, etc. (12 staff members)
- Division of certified staff all hands on deck for these days (counselors, etc.)
- Coordinator and Head of School left free on those days (account for subs)
- Design Teachers launched project with UN's Global Goals (staff/students). We learned last year why the 8GCP cannot live in one subject area and next year will be shared by 3 different subject groups.



## What Worked? 8GCP Presentations to 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Audience "4 Months in 4 Minutes"

- 7th Grade Audience feedback forms on presentations
- 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Film Students filmed all presentations and placed in Google Drive that same week (student reflections)

#### Perceived Problems from this year Poss

#### Possible Solutions for Next Year

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Some students lacking the skills to complete the project (ATL skills specific for the project)	Analyze those Community Project ATLs with the proposed ATL skills for next year. Do we see a good alignment? These will be directly taught and assessed <i>next year</i> .
Community Project only discussed in Design Classes - no real support from other subject areas.	World's Largest Lesson Goals (sustainability) or another 'global' idea could be taught and researched in other subject areas.
Issues Noted: Works cited Presentation Skills Open-Inquiry Research Step-by-Step Planning	Are all teachers now requiring MLA formatting and are 8th grade teachers requiring works cited several x per year? #### Reflection Comments (shared with staff)

"This needs to be more of a COMMUNITY PROJECT in the largest sense of the word. More subject areas need to be discussing the 8GCP and giving it some time and space in other subject areas." (students)

"Do we have teacher experts that can really help our students to "present" or "research" etc.?" (Design teachers)

"If we could directly teach/practice the ATL skills needed to complete this 8GCP, we'd be in good shape. Many students are lacking the skills for this type of open inquiry – sustained project." (MYP Coordinator) – Impact for ATL implementation across the years.




